Participation numbers, forms and the road book will be distributed to competitors during the Administrative Control.

4.3 Calculation of the Coefficient Penalty (year of manufacture - cubic capacity) In calculating the penalties, there will be a coefficient for each car that is timed, which will be based on its age and cubic capacity. The use of the COEFFICIENT only concerns the calculation of the delay penalties at the various EDA control points. All other penalties (time at the SEX and administrative) will be applied without the use of a coefficient.

$$\text{coef} = \left(\frac{\text{year} - 1900}{100} \right) \cdot \left[0.7 + 0.3 \cdot \left(\frac{cc}{1000} \right) \right]$$

6.2 Insurance

The participation fee also includes the crew's Third Party Liability insurance, in accordance with the following:

The general provisions of the contract stipulate that competitors are covered for third party liability with the following amounts:

- a. For Bodily Injury or Death (for each accident) up to an amount of 1,220,000
- b. For Material Damage (for each accident or incident) up to an amount of 1,220,000

6.2.1 The Organizers bear no responsibility for any accident that occurs by or to a participant or participating cars throughout the duration of the event. The Organizers also bear no responsibility for any violation of Greek Laws and rules.

6.2.2 This Insurance is valid from the start, and ceases to be valid after the end of the event or from the moment of abandonment or exclusion from it. Only during the event as defined by the Road Book.

6.2.3. Crews must ensure that their vehicles have insurance coverage in Greece and roadside assistance.

9.4 Regularity Tests

During the event, a number of RTs will be held on roads open to traffic. The starting method is from a standstill without a judge (self start) or Auto start or on the move (flying) where you enter without stopping.

The average speed in all RTs will not be greater than 50 km/h. Crews must finish the RTs following the average speed or the time set by the Organizer. The Race Director has the right to cancel an RT or part of it, before, during or after it, for reasons of force majeure (e.g. natural phenomena), safety (e.g. accident outside or inside the event), error in the Road book, pronunciation error and generally when he judges or it is proven that most crews did not experience the same conditions for its execution, e.g. they were interrupted by mobile or physical obstacles that cannot be foreseen in the design or in the road book or identified in time by the navigator of the event.

9.5 Timings – RTs Starts

Participants have the right to delete one (1) and unique timing (joker use) throughout the race. The “Joker use” only concerns timings within E.D.A. and not penalties from S.E.X. (T.C). The use of Joker will be applied automatically by the Organizing Committee. The rationale for this deletion (joker use) is related to the fact that E.D.A. is held on open roads where some crews unintentionally interrupt their pace or course by mobile or physical obstacles

that cannot be foreseen in the design or in the road book or identified in time by the navigator of the event.

9.5.2 R.Ts START FROM A STOP (Auto Start) In RTs . with a stop start "Auto Start" the vehicles will MANDATORY start IN A FULL MINUTE. Starting at any other time than a full minute is NOT acceptable by the timing system. A specific time is given for starting within the opening and closing of the R.T. (e.g. 11:00-12:20). The crews will start upon their arrival at the R.T starting point, one vehicle per full minute and will note their starting time on the card, under their responsibility, so that it can be confirmed by the satellite timing system. The timing system 100-200 meters after the starting point will automatically recognize their exact starting time to the FULL MINUTE, and crews no longer have the right to return to the starting point, nor to request a new starting time from the Organization.
